Courses taught:

2013-2018: Creation, management and teaching of an “applied-research seminar” entitled: **“*Mise en Oeuvre d'une Pensée Critique en Economie et Management*”**

This seminar was part of mandatory classes for Bachelor and Parallel admission Master Students (AP2/AST2 Bordeaux, Marseille, and Engineer students from partner institutions) of the Programme Grande Ecole - PGE

It was the first experiment of a Critical Thinking research seminar taught, each year, to 1400 students (applied to the reinvention of local economies and management practices) using the flipped e-learning mode served by the LEARN digital platform and a pedagogy of team organization and management (8 to 10 students).

2008-2015: Creation, management and team teaching of an applied research seminar entitled: **“*Géoéconomie des Ressources Rares en Exploitation Responsable*”**.

This elective module was taught to Master Students of Kedge Programme Grande Ecole (PGE) and third-year Engineers students from Ecole Nationale Supérieure de Chimie, de Biologie et de Physique (ENSCBP).
