- Occasionally the questions in the class became too personal. This was largely due to other members of the class. The instructor perhaps should make sure the discussion stays on track.
- When getting exams back, for the essay section, I would get points deducted but no comments were on the test to help me improve my writing to get a better grade and learn from it. I would say give a little more constructive feedback on exams. I think it would have really helped me to
- improve my writing. Some of the reading were really long even when split up into two parts. I would try to make those more on the weekend if possible to allow for more time to be able to read it. I found myself starting and then running out of time to read with work and other school work.
 - more freedom in what we read (choices)
 - If there was any discrepancy that I had with the course, it was the amount of readings per week that we were required to accomplish. Reading anything can be very taxing on a student and with so much reading it all tends to blur together.
 - She always had us work in groups and I personally hate group work
 - order of the reading is a bit confusing and unorganized; it was difficult to understand the point of the course sometimes
