This is the last time of the world, let every Church and Christian be faithful to God lest the Church be removed from God's favour (Rev 2:5), and the Christians lose our rewards (1 Corinthians 3:15, 1 Peter 4:17, Luke 21:36, Philippians 2:12). Without getting our faith right, we will not worship and please God (Hebrews 11:6).

- 1. The Word sanctify Christians, cleanse the Church and prepare her to be fitter for Christ and Heaven (Eph 5:26, John 17:17, John 15:3, 2 Timothy 2:21, 2 Peter 1:11).
- 2. The Church is to build up the saints based on the teachings of the Word (the prophets and apostles) until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God (Eph 4:11-13, 2 Peter 1:6, 2 Peter 1:8, Romans 6:17).
- 3. The grown-up body of Christ will definitely shine with glory wherever God enables us to (2 Timothy 3:16-17, Hebrews 13:21, 2 Peter 1:3)
- 4. Without greater understanding about God, Christians and Churches are doomed to fall to the schemes of Satan, to the ways of this world and of the ruler of the power of the air, and self-centredness (2 Corinthians 2:11, Eph 2:2, James 4:4, Titus 1:16, 1 John 5:4).
- 5. Christians and Churches cannot obey God's commands without first understand the commands. Lacking in this obedient is a show of lacking in love for God (1 John 5:3). Godliness will be without power, and these Christians and Churches are almost useless of any real and good works (2 Timothy 3:5, 2 Peter 1:8-9).
- 6. Live our life as a minister and steward of God as led by the Holy Spirit because those belong to God are led by the Spirit of God (1 Peter 4:10-11, Roman 8:14, Hebrews 1:7).
- 7. No one should judge another for not serving the Lord in the way decided by the Church because the individual Christian conscience is towards God and to be respected. This is the repeated teaching of the Bible (Roman 12:1, Roman 13:5, Romans 14:12, Romans 14:22, 1 Peter 2:19, Romans 2:15, Romans 8:16, 2 Corinthians 1:12, Acts 24:16, Hebrews 13:18, 2 Corinthians 5:11)
- 8. Salvation is the product of grace and faith to all God's elects (<u>Eph 2:8</u>, <u>Romans 8:29</u>). Redemption of souls belongs to God alone (<u>Romans 9:16</u>, <u>Eph 2:5</u>).
- 9. Gospel must inform about the judgment of sin, mediatorship of Christ Jesus as the ransom to God for our sin, have peace with God saved from the wrath of God, rejoice in suffering for the sake of righteousness as in the process of sanctification, to set our minds on things that are above not on things that are on earth (Colossians 3:2), to have endurance, character and hope because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us (Roman 5:1-5).
- 10. Gospel work must be pleasing to God not men (Galatians 1:10).
